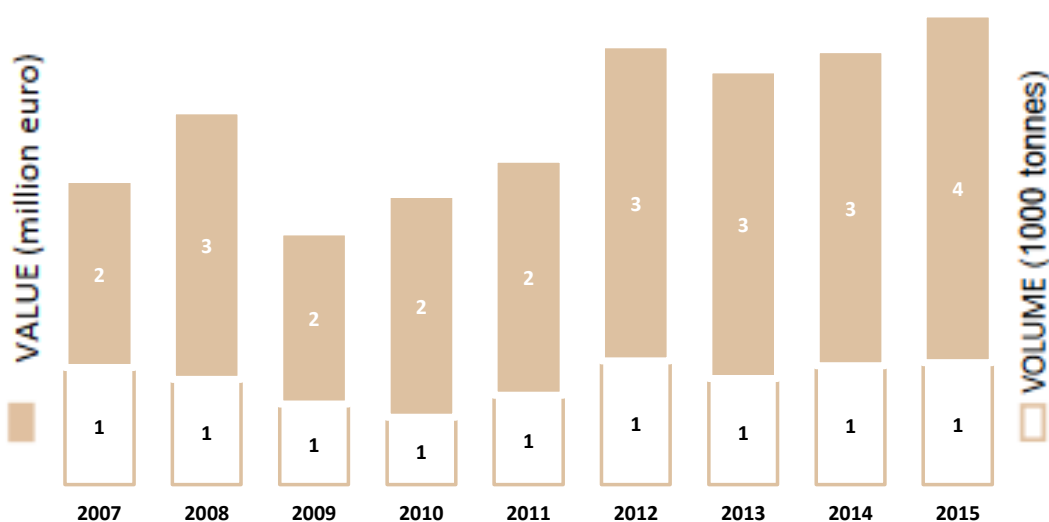


## AQUACULTURE

Aquaculture refers to the farming of aquatic (freshwater or saltwater) organisms, such as fish, molluscs, crustaceans and aquatic plants. Aquaculture data are reported in live weight equivalent and value.

In Slovakia, all fish products are farmed in freshwater. The most important aquaculture methods are:

- 48% in ponds;
- 40% in recirculation systems.

(million euro and 1.000 tonnes)

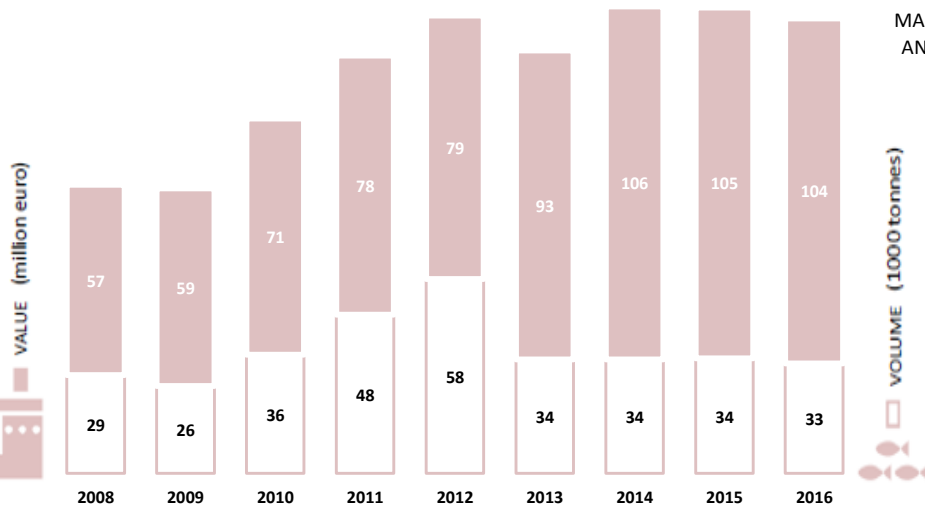

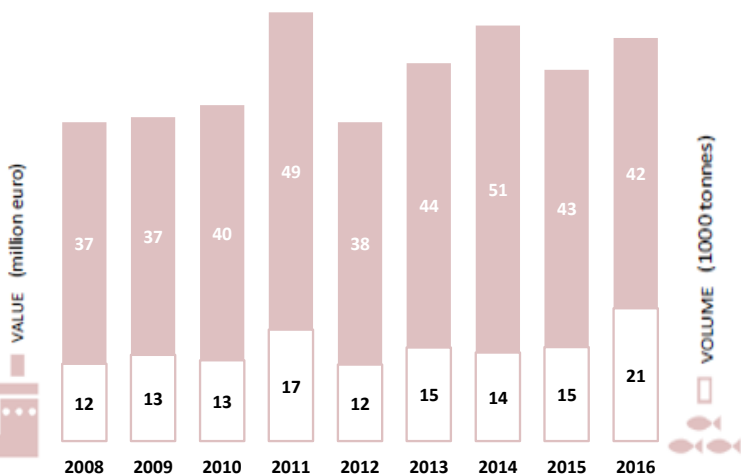

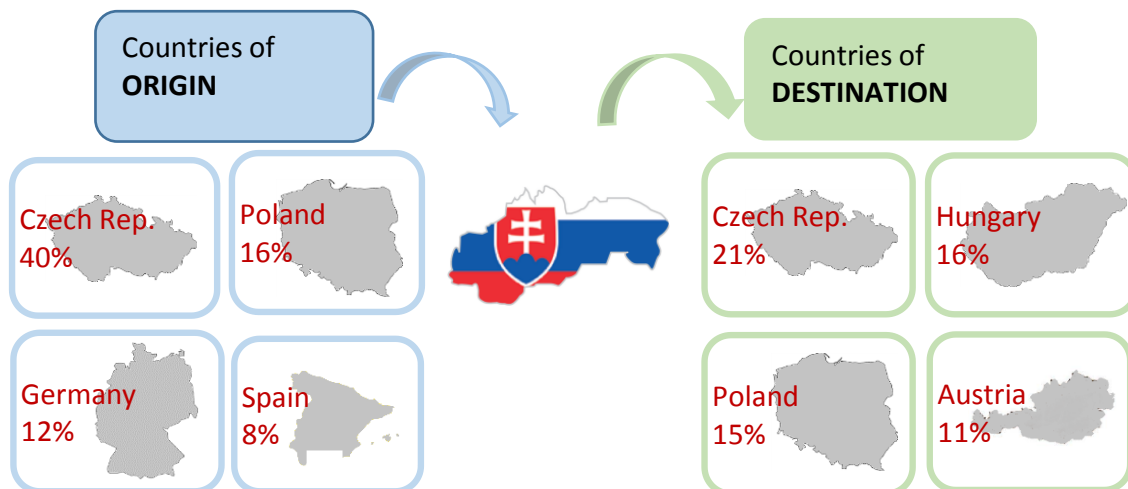

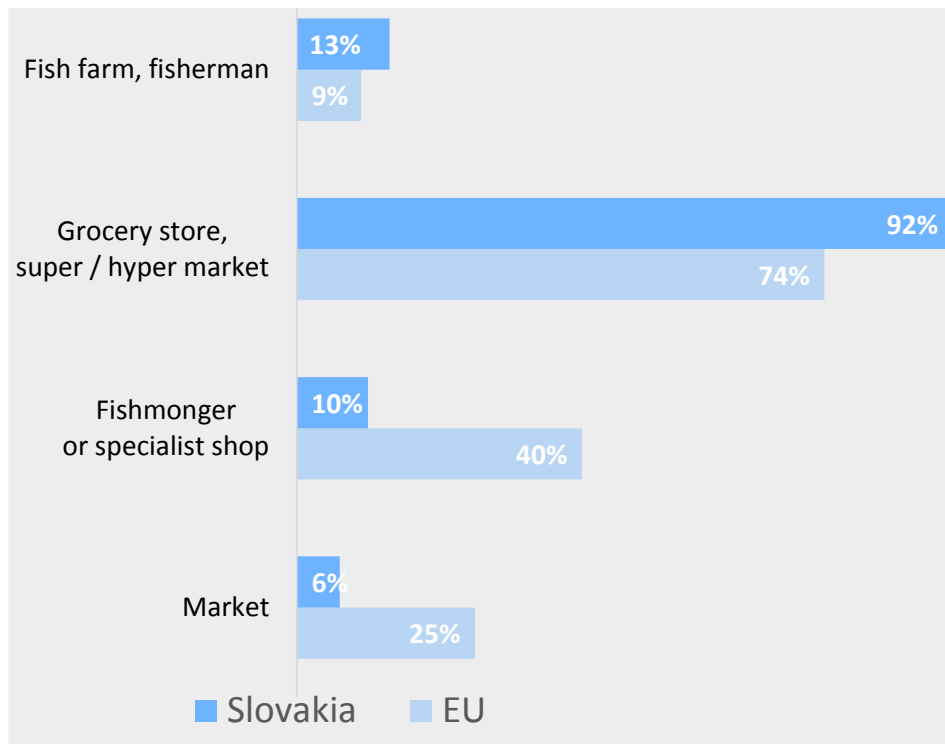

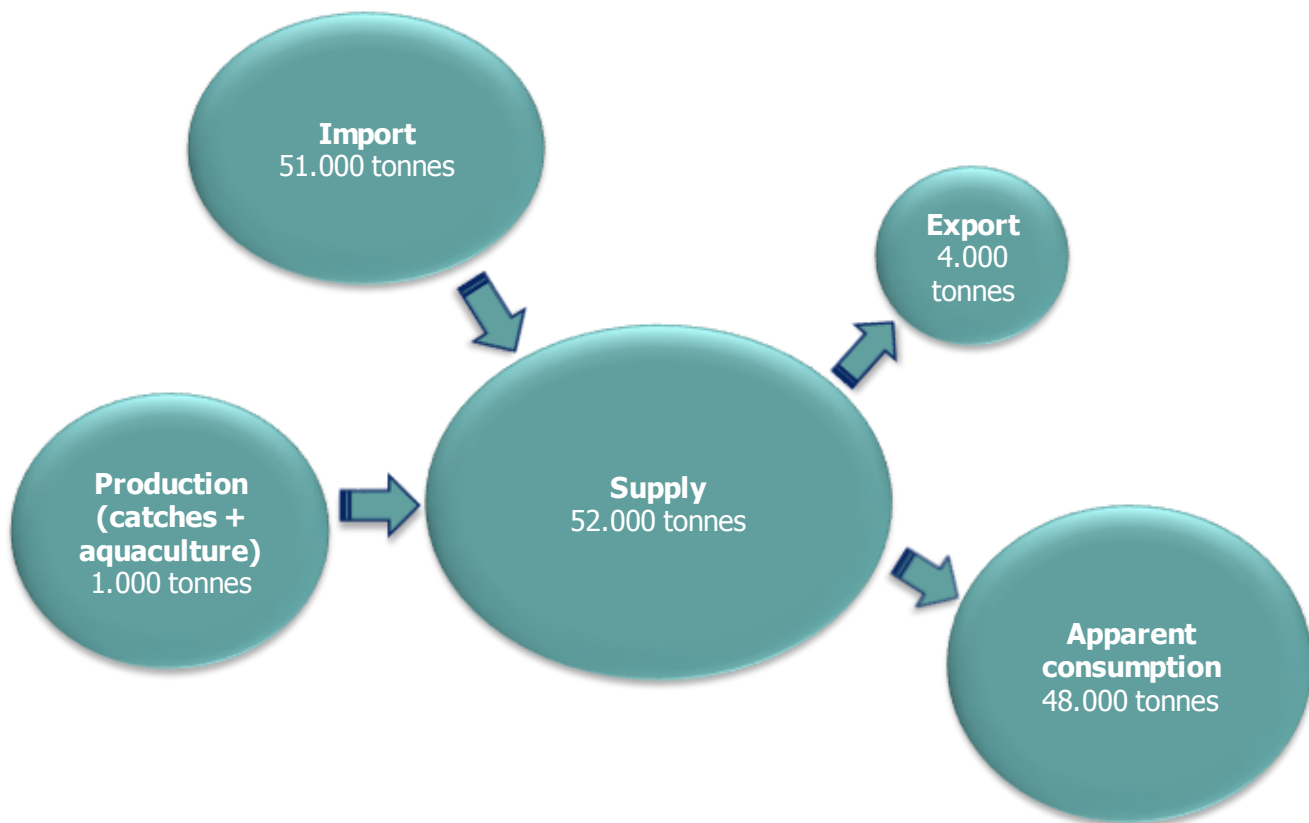
### Consumers preferences on purchasing channels

# CONSUMPTION

Apparent consumption of fishery and aquaculture products in Slovakia amounted to **8,2 kg/per capita in 2015**, a 7% increase compared to the previous year.

Main consumed species are **hake, octopus, shrimp, cod, squid and salmon**.

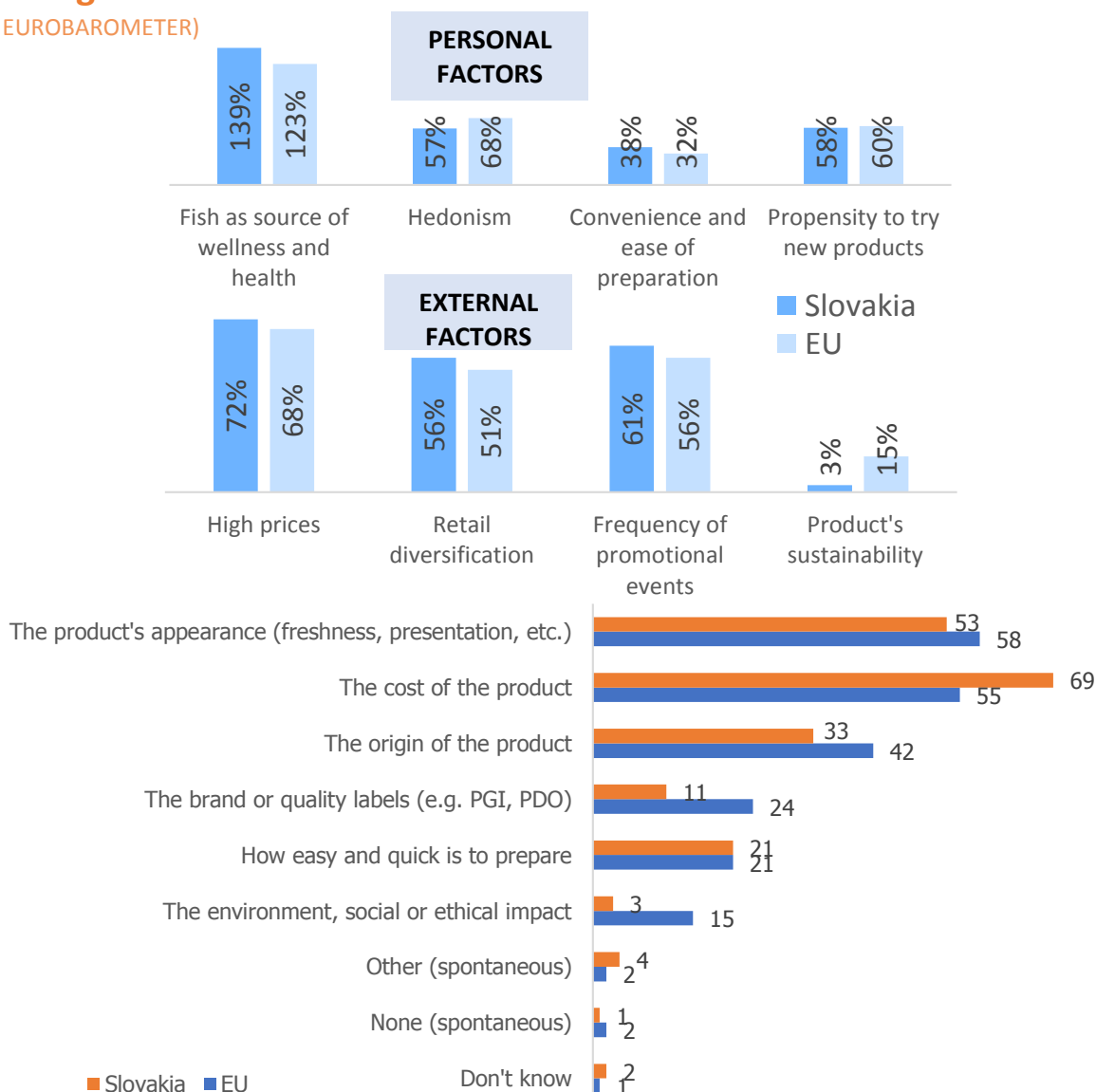
From a socio-demographic point of view, regular fish consumers belong mainly to age classes 15-24 years and 49-55 years. The number of regular fish consumers in all socio-demographic groups is lower than the EU average (source: "EU consumer habits regarding fishery and aquaculture products").

People from Slovakia consume especially tinned products, while prepacked fish is more frequently consumed (76%) than the EU average (62%).
